Since our founding, Bacoa has provided vital services to the Barrington Area, helping older adults, their families and their caregivers access much needed food, healthcare, transportation, housing, community support, and more. This past year, we've expanded our organization's role as a community leader, introducing our "Dementia Friendly Barrington Area" initiative to reduce the stigma of dementia and provide "Dementia Readiness" trainings, medical ID alert bracelets, and dementia services to the Barrington Area. We've also developed fresh and exciting ways to promote our programs and services, reaching more clients than ever before.

Bacoa's dedication to go the extra mile for our clients makes us uniquely qualified to work with older adults, developing care plans that match their needs, wants, and abilities. While providing critical services like the 2,655 meals we served and the 286 free rides we gave last year, we never forget the importance of taking the time to make sure our clients feel heard. I recall a recent comment from a client after coming in for an appointment to talk about their housing situation. "I felt so much calmer and prepared to address the situation after our conversation," the client said, praising our staff for making them feel heard.

From the 430 clients we helped file taxes to the \$206,392 we saved older adults on prescription medications, all of our services could not have been provided without the support of our amazing donors and community partners. You all have made a difference in so many lives. I thank you so much for your commitment to Bacoa's mission to promote vibrant, healthy aging.

Active Aging


Many Bacoa clients attend multiple "Active Aging" clubs, programs, and trips, building important long-term social connections that combat the negative health effects of isolation on older adults.







