While providing critical services like the 2,655 meals we served and the 286 free rides we gave last year, we never forget the importance of taking the time to make sure our clients feel heard. Active Aging

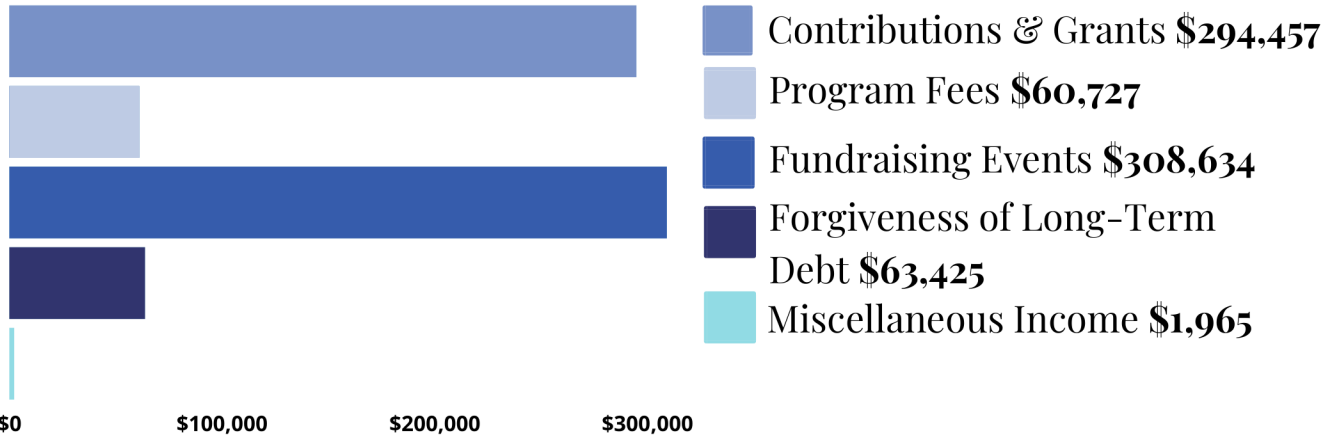
Many Bacoa clients attend multiple "Active Aging" clubs, programs, and trips, building important long-term social connections that combat the negative health effects of isolation on older adults.



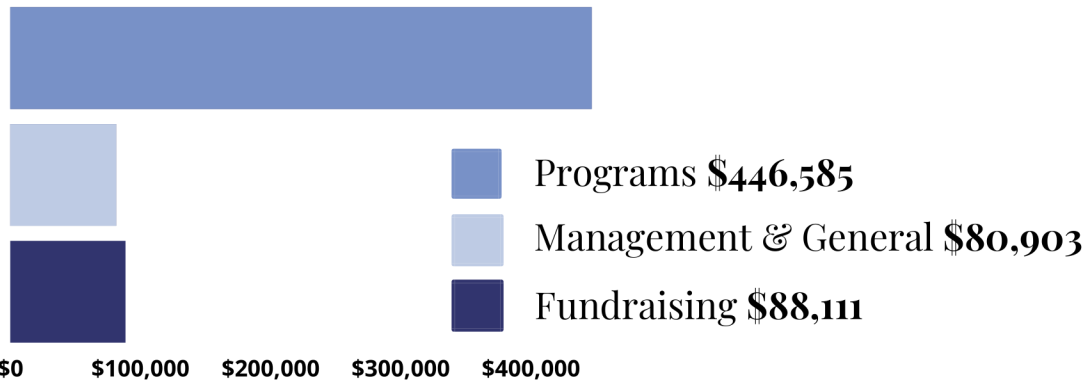
Fiscal Year in Review 2021-2022



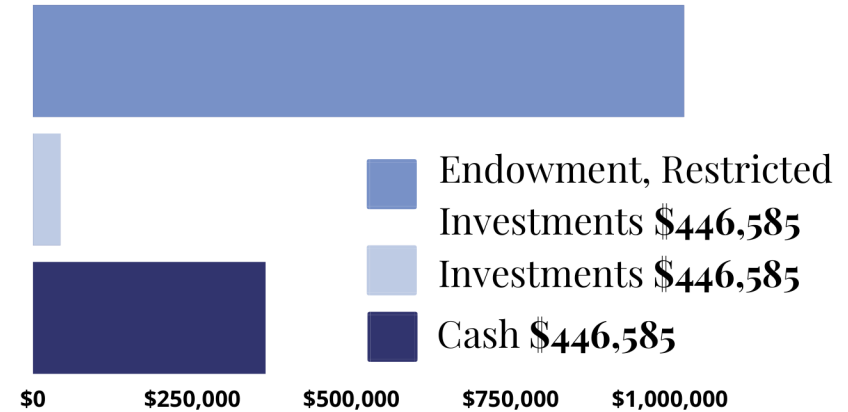
Net Operating Revenues **\$678,903** (Gross Revenues \$729,208)
