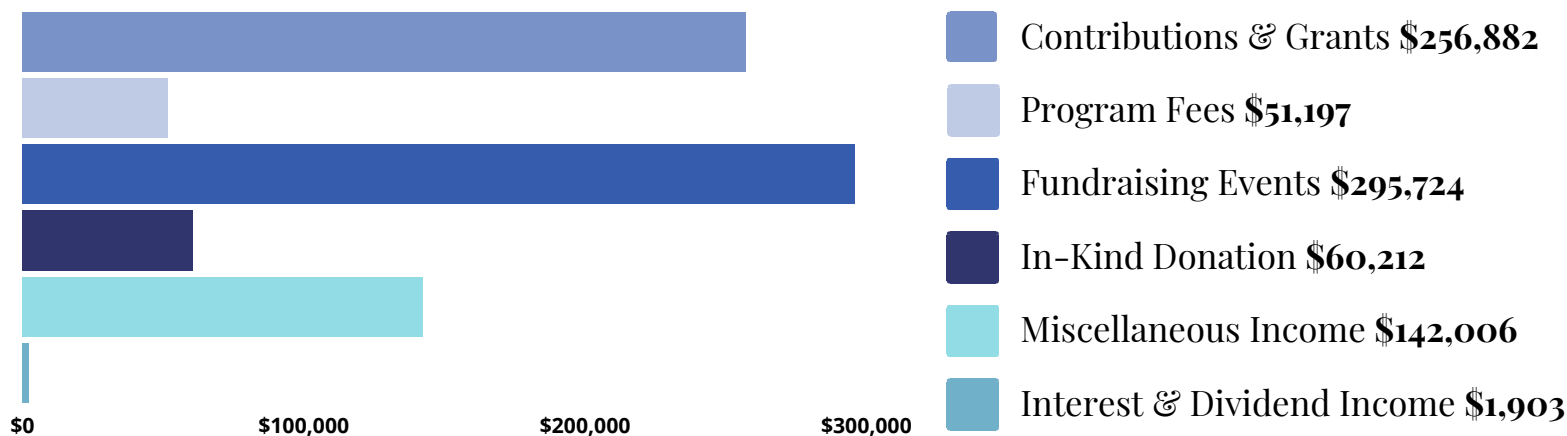

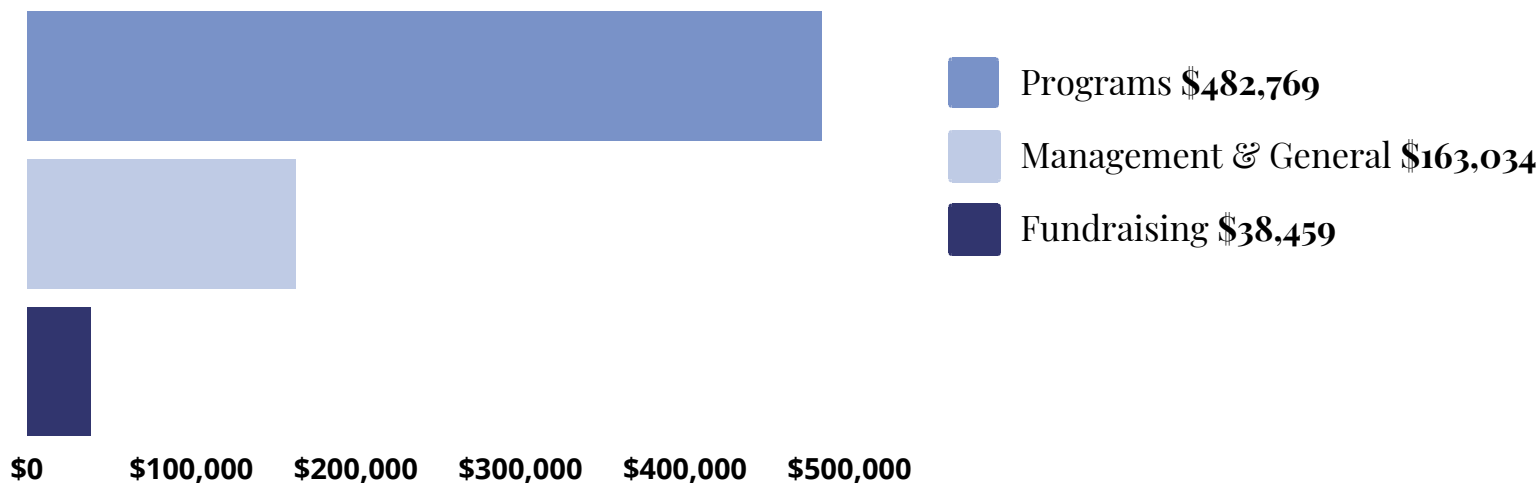

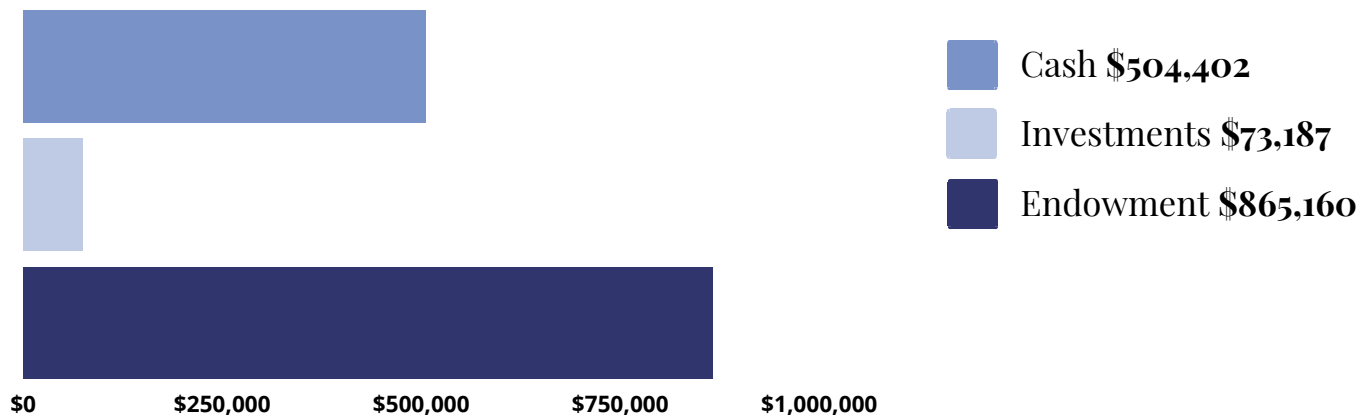
Net Operating Revenues: \$807,924
